Where does green power come from?

Renewable or green power is produced by generating facilities that do not use fossil fuels for generation. Green power can be generated from solar, wind, landfill gas, geothermal, and wave projects and unlike fossil fuel, green energy does not produce a carbon foot print. It's clean, renewable and, it's good for the environment.



Why does Lane Electric offer a "green power" program?

Because we believe in renewable energy and because our members have asked us for it. By participating in a green power program, you can help Lane Electric include green energy generated by wind, geothermal, solar, landfill gas, wave and small-hydro sources in their renewable resource portfolio.



What kinds of "green power" can I buy from Lane Electric?

Currently, Lane Electric offers wind power generated at the State-line Wind Project in Northeast Oregon and Southeast Washington and solar power generated from a one-megawatt array at the King Estate Winery just south of Eugene.. We fully expect that within a short time, additional green resources will be available to include in our renewable resource portfolio.



How does "green power" get to my house?

Similar to other generating facilities, these green generating sites are connected directly to the electric grid, and the green kilowatt-hours are supplied to your home the same way, over the same power lines, that supply your home today.

Questions & Answers



What happens if the wind doesn't blow or the sun doesn't shine?

You will continue receiving electricity at your home. The green power you purchase today is "backed up" by the same clean, reliable and renewable hydro-system you've become accustomed to in the past.



Can I only buy "green power?"

If you like, you may buy green power blocks (100 kWh each) equal to what your monthly average electrical usage is. That is to say that if on average, your monthly electrical usage is 1500 kWh, you are eligible to buy up to 15 blocks of green power. Remember, each block of green power costs \$2 so in this example, an additional \$30 would be added to your electric bill for green power.

Sample calculation:

1500 avg. kWh per month ÷ 100 kWh/block = 15 blocks. 15 x \$2/block = \$30 which is **added to your electric bill** for your green power purchase.



Is "green power" more expensive than the power I buy today?

Yes. Green power is a little more expensive than the electricity you currently purchase. Whether or not you elect to participate is strictly voluntary. Any green power you elect to buy will be added to your electric bill.
